The regular meeting of the Lake County LEPC (Local Emergency Planning Committee) was called to order by Chair Jerry Johnson at the hour of 04:35 pm.

Silent roll call was taken with the following members present: Jerry Johnson, Lou Vogt, Chuck Pulford, Ken Meyer, Kory Reck & Deb Reinicke.

Agenda/Additions:

Motion by Ken Meyer to approve the agenda as presented. Second by Lou Vogt. M/C All were ayes.

Minutes/Corrections:

Motion by Kory to approve as read. Second by Ken. M/C All were ayes.

Treasurer's Report:

\$7,462.22 as of 4-18-2007; expenses were \$79.80; LEPC \$1,839.09. Motion by Kory to approve the treasurer's report. Second by Lou. M/C All were ayes.

Old Business:

Looking through (2004) budget. Checking on the window's program. Ask about the \$400.00 for the colored printer.

Kory asked about the sirens. Ken is not familiar with this, only what he has seen in the paper.

New Business:

Discussion on Sioux Falls Fire rescue hazmat response team—they will respond when they can help. Mutual aid/contract—6 months expired—beyond our control—need to call them—now we could go with anyone in this field. Costly hourly rate—should be billed to the responsible party. Without contract they will respond. The contract was a requirement by Minnehaha County. Technical assistance. Kory very comfortable that all our local Fire Depts are trained to respond.

Grant was discussed. Monies from the grant are: \$1,839.09.

LEPC equipment purchases discussed—boom kits and laptop upgrades—Madison's model is a 1999 and Wentworth's model is a 2000. Jerry stated that East River was paid \$250.00 Floatable booms were discussed. There are 12' & 4' absorbent socks. Lab Safety supplier—plastic drum—contained only 2 suits—these protect a person. Don't know the cost of booms—Ordered a catalog and have not gotten info from East River at this time.

NIMS equipment typing was discusses—Master list for Fire Depts in County. Their resources such as type 1 engines—Jerry talked about the difficulty in typing engines. State EMA want resources that each could provide the types are how the fire depts. are paid. Rates of pay are types 1,2,3 etc. Money for other entities for expenses such as gas, etc.

Full scale exercise was discussed—talking about the end of July—multi jurisdiction. Domestic Seed & airport—involve everyone. Our next meeting will be July 18th, 2007.

NIMS ICS training requirements & implications were discussed—Need to fill trl. Motion by Kory, Second by Lou to purchased the items for the Trl. M/C All were ayes. Totes to store items in, and also booms \$128.00. List is on the bottom of the budget FY2007. ICS 100 & 200 effect the future monies. Have to be up to standards. ICS 700 is on line and there have been trouble taking this. You can print off overview and then take on line. Take the test and submit print off and answer sheet. Not meeting standards effects each additional dept. City Commissioners are ok with this but Jerry is not sure about other City officials.

Meeting adjourned at the hour of 5:25 pm. Jerry thanked all of us for attending.
