Jay Leibel Atty, Bob Baumberger Lake County landowner, Ryan Zwart & Charley Zwart Moody County landowners discussed sharing the costs of cleaning out the Bull Ditch. CDI Civil Design Inc. presented (10-19-2009) to Wm Ellingson Moody County State's Atty an estimate of \$8,400 for an engineering study to determine the conditions of the Bull Ditch. A fund raiser by area landowners/farmers raised \$2,800 1/3 of the money for that particular study. Residents are requesting Lake County to help fund a 3 way contribution of \$2,800/\$8,400 (estimate) to fund the engineering study. Preliminary study could begin as soon as possible depending on the spring conditions. Motion Pedersen, second Hageman Lake County participates in this study in the amount up to \$2,800, contingent upon Moody County participating, also the Moody Co. landowners contributing \$2,800. Moody County to handle the financials with this Bull Ditch project. Motion carried.
