**Charles Scholl/Chuck's Recycling and Repair, Inc** Conditional Use permit for property located at N802' W1275' NE ¼ exc S607' of E 817' NE ¼ Sec 25 Concord Twp parcel #4450B. Requesting to start salvage & recycling business in the "AG" District. Regulations require a "Conditional Use" in the "AG" District for this type of business. Present was Charles Scholl, Greg Protsch Atty, Deb Reinicke Zoning-Drainage, Ken Meyer State's Atty and Shelli Gust Sec and five concerned citizens. Motion Giles, second Bohl authorize the Chairman to sign and adopt the 8 page Conditional Use Permit of Chuck's Recycling and Repair, Inc. document. Motion carried. Atty Protsch asked the Auditor to indicate in the record, that Mr. Scholl has not

specifically agreed to all the conditions set forth in the Conditional Use Permit. He would like to note on the record that he objects to all of the conditions, except for the (4) conditions that are allowed to be imposed pursuant to your Zoning Ordinance. Those 4 conditions are set forth on the top of Pg 2. Reason for objecting, making an objection on the record to the conditions, Mr. Scholl would have 30 days to appeal this decision of this board to the circuit court for judicial review. He may or may not appeal. If he does, he is merely exercising his statutory rights; he may not appeal. If he does not appeal and he desires to accept it, he will accept it in writing prior to commencement of the business as required in the permit.
