

LAKE COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
July 6, 2010

The Board of Lake County Commissioners met in Regular Session on July 6, 2010 at 9 a.m. with the following members present: Dan Bohl, Chris Giles, Roger Hageman, Scott Pedersen, Bert Verhey and Auditor Kay A. Schmidt. Chairman Verhey called the meeting to order.

Martin Jarrett Chairman Water Quality Committee, Jan Nicolay, Linda Hilde, Terry Ryan & Kent Petersen. Jarrett thanked the Commission for their consideration to hire an Environmental/Code Enforcement Officer. Financial support from Lake Madison Development Assoc would contribute \$5,000 for 3 yrs and Jay Gilbertson Director, East Dakota Water Consr District would contribute \$15,000 per year.
