

LAKE COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
June 1, 2010

The Board of Lake County Commissioners met in Regular Session on June 1, 2010 at 9 a.m. with the following members present: Dan Bohl, Chris Giles, Roger Hageman, Scott Pedersen, Bert Verhey and Auditor Kay A. Schmidt. Chairman Verhey called the meeting to order.

AGENDA APPROVED:

Motion Hageman, second Bohl approves agenda of June 1, 2010. Additions: Winfred surplus property auction. Motion carried.

ABATEMENT #10-7:

Shirley Ebsen Dir of Equalization presented Abatement #10-7 Thomas Murray 1708 N. Tahoe Trail Sioux Falls, SD 57110 \$259.49. Land value was adjusted at 2010 county boards to a value equal to adjoining land owners in same development. Property taxes payable in 2009 payable 2010 are also from an incorrect value. PSIC GRANT:

Don Thomson EMA-Veterans Officer presented information on narrow banding requirements that go into effect January 2013 that will cause all communication equipment to be reprogrammed or replaced. Initial \$5,000 will be used with the 80/20 match Public Safety Interoperative Communications (PSIC) grant which would provide a \$30,000 purchasing package for radios. Motion Giles, second Bohl approves \$5000 for the 80/20 match and \$500 to purchase software and activation keys so that most of the digital radios can be reprogrammed locally. Motion carried.
