

LAKE COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
May 18, 2010

The Board of Lake County Commissioners met in Regular Session on May 18, 2010 at 9 a.m. with the following members present: Dan Bohl, Roger Hageman, Scott Pedersen, Bert Verhey and Auditor Kay A. Schmidt. Absent: Chris Giles. Chairman Verhey called the meeting to order.

AGENDA APPROVED:

Motion Bohl, second Hageman approves agenda of May 18, 2010. Motion carried.

ONE DAY MALT BEVERAGE:

Motion Pedersen, second Bohl approves One Day Malt Beverage license \$50.00 for Northern Bull Riding Tour at Prairie Village on June 11, 2010 hosted by the Madison Fire Dept. Motion carried.

LETTER OF SUPPORT:

Motion Pedersen, second Bohl allow Chairman Verhey to sign a letter of support with Bennett County to temporarily increase the 911 surcharge (.75 to \$2.00) to help all counties to defray the cost of 911 PSAP and 911 responder costs until the State makes a final decision on a permanent funding protocol. Motion carried.

Motion Pedersen, second Bohl convene as a Board of Adjustment with Shelli Gust State's Atty Assistant present due to the absence of Deb Reinicke Zoning-Drainage Officer. Motion carried.

VARIANCE:

Troy Wermers property located at Lot 2 of Mader's 2nd Addition, parcel #3069D Sec 4 Herman Twp. Corey Strom presented the variance request. Requesting 25' side yard and 39' back yard variance. Garage will be 24x26 and enter the garage from the driveway on the south lot line. Motion Hageman, second Bohl approves Troy Wermers variance. Motion carried.

Under Section 1101: "AG" Area Regulations: Side Yard: There shall be a side yard on each side of the building having a width of not less than 30 feet. Rear Yard: There shall be a rear yard having a depth of not less than 50 feet or 20% of the depth of the buildable lot at the time of the passage of this Resolution.

Dan & Jerry's Greenhouse property located at Lot 3 Carson's Addition, parcel #1780 W ½ Sec 10 Lakeview Twp. Requesting to move out a 1986 trailer home and replace it with a 1992. Present was Ryan Johnson. Motion Pedersen, second Hageman approves Dan & Jerry's Greenhouse variance. Motion carried.

Under Section 246: Definitions: Type A & B Manufactured Homes-the age of the manufactured house may not exceed 15 years from the date of manufacture. Under Section 1101: "AG" Permitted Uses: #2 Single family dwellings including Type A & B manufactured homes.

Kelly Jung property located at N979' W890' NE ¼ parcel #2524A Sec 13 Le Roy Twp. Requesting to have a repair shop. Present was Kelly Jung. Motion Pedersen, second Bohl approves Kelly Jung conditional use. Motion carried.

#5. Extended home occupations are occupations engaged in by occupants of a dwelling provided that: 1. Individuals engaged in such occupation shall consist of family members residing on the premises and up to three (3) non-family employees, 2. There shall be no change in the outside appearance of the buildings or premises, or other visible evidence of the conduct of such home occupation other than one on-site sign, not to exceed two (2) square feet in area, non-illuminated. 3. The only retail sales allowed consists of commodities prepared on the premises in connection with such occupation or activity. 4. There shall be no outdoor storage of materials, vehicles, etc. related to the extended home occupation. 5. Extended home occupations shall be agriculturally related and be conducted in an accessory building. 6. No traffic shall be generated by such home occupation in greater volumes than would normally be expected in a residential neighborhood, and any need of parking generated by the conduct of such home occupation shall be provided off the street and other than in a required front yard. G. Pursuant to Section 1209, the Board of Adjustment finds that this extended home occupation would not conflict with adjoining land uses.
