**ORDER OF INCORPORATION OF  
LAKES COMMUNITY ROAD DISTRICT**

Whereas, on, July 6, 2010 the Lake County Commission acknowledged receipt Of Petitions for the formation of Lakes Community Road District subject to the approval by the landowners registered to vote within the district; and

Whereas, the first and second notice of the voter registration deadline for the election on the incorporation of the Lakes Community Road District was published; and

Whereas, the first and second notice of election for the incorporation of the Lakes Community Road District was published; and

Whereas, the Lake County Auditor appointed electors and judges for the election for the incorporation of the Lakes Community Road District; and

Whereas, the election on the incorporation of the Lakes Community Road District was held on Tuesday, August 31, 2010, with (103) registered voters, and

Whereas, the Lake County Auditor has canvassed the election and the results of the Election 43 in favor of incorporation and 15 against incorporation;

Now, Therefore, It Is Ordered that based upon the above and foregoing, the Board of the Lake County Commission is satisfied with the legality of the election and Orders and declares that the Lakes Community Road District is incorporated by the name adopted.

Further, It Is Ordered that this Order shall be conclusive of the fact of such Incorporation and all suits by or against the Lakes Community Road District pursuant to SDCL 31-12A-11.

Further, It Is Ordered that Lake County pay out of its funds the necessary sum for the holding of the election on the incorporation of the road district as well as the election for and meeting of trustees of the road district.
